- TASTING NOTES
The fruit is from our emblematic Alto de Piedras vineyard in Isla de Maipo. It is a deep and intense colour and reveals aromatic layers of spices, black pepper and black fruit in which the notes of oak and leather from the ageing are perfectly integrated. In the mouth, it is medium-bodied and intensely fruity with a silky texture and very fine tannins that are beautifully balanced with the fresh acidity. With a very long finish, this wine is reaching its maturity and demonstrating all of its great potential.

Cellaring Recommendation: from 5 to 10 years.
Serving Temperature: 16°C
Decantation: Recommended.
